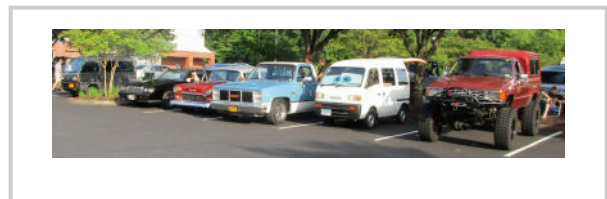
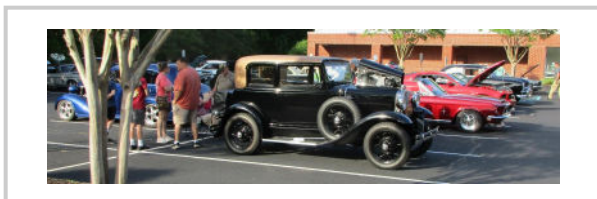
## Brookdale Chambrel Williamsburg Visit May 22
