Veterans Day Service and Ceremony- Historic Grace Church Yorktown (Today)

Join Historic Grace Episcopal Church, Yorktown (ca 1697) for a Veteran's Day prayer service in the historic church. Today at 111 Church Street Yorktown. Following the service, we'll proceed to the churchyard for a brief ceremony that will include the playing of "Taps" and a hand salute (as appropriate for active duty military/veterans) or with reverence, to the 113 known veterans (Revolutionary War, Civil War, World Wars 1 & 2, Cold War, Korean War & Vietnam) buried in the Grace cemetery and all deceased men and women who have served our country in uniform. The graves of known Veterans buried in the Church Cemetery have a Veterans marker and US Flag. The historic church bell (ca 1725) will then be tolled 21 times as part of the nationwide "Bells of Peace" initiative.
