HVPR Co-Sponsors 4th Invitational Car Show

The 4th Invitational Car Show was held on Main Street, Yorktown VA, Saturday May 10th. The show was presented by the York County Department of Economic and Tourism Development and the Historic Virginia Peninsula Region Antique Automobile Club of America (HVPR AACA). HVPR Committee members and Volunteers arrived early to greet and register participants. There were 31 vehicles on display and over 1,000 visitors! Kevin Ritchie (York County) and Celeste Gucanac, co-owner of Mobjak Bay Coffee Roasters welcome participants and spectators for a great day of fun, sharing memories and smiles with the owners of the Vintage Vehicles on Display, learning about the enjoying the history of Yorktown, and patronizing the merchants in the historic area and vendors at the Vintage Market on Water Street. Virginia State Delegate Chad Green 69th District thanked show organizers and stayed to thank visitors and participants at the end of the show. Cars on display ranged from a 1926 Ford Model T and Ford Model As to post-war suburban, sports import, and muscle cars. Novelty automobiles included Jim Elliott's 1953 Chevrolet Good Humor Ice Cream Truck, John Atkinson's 1956 Oldsmobile 'dune tour' convertible, Al and Linda Crane's "Wizard of OZ" 1965 Mustang and a "Mad Max Road Warrior Car" owned by James DeGuzman. Other HVPR cars on display included Larry and Cathy Munk's 1928 Ford Model A Coupe, John Wyatt's 1930 Ford Model A Victoria, Keith Colonna's 1956 Lincoln Mark II, Greg and Anita Smith's 1959 Nash Metropolitan, Roger and Judy Cross's 1966 Mustang coupe, Pete and Pamela Romeo's 1968 Plymouth GTX, Jonathan Smith's 1968 Chrysler New Yorker, Bob Stein's 1993 Buick Century station wagon, and Justin and Calie Mowery's 1997 Suzuki Every. 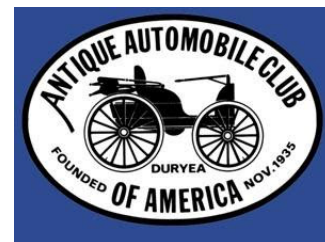
