The Scarpelli's car was selected to be on display in the big Carlisle Expo Center with about 50 other cars. Their car was one of 6 DeSotos selected to be in the arena which included cars as far back as the 1920s. The year 2025 marked the 100th anniversary of the Chrysler Corporation which was founded by Walter P. Chrysler in 1925. The entire event attracted thousands of spectators for this special celebration of all eras of Chrysler brands.
