## HVPR Tour to Schaubach's

The Historic Virginia Peninsula Region (HVPR) had a perfect sunny skies and warm weather for a tour to Dwight Schaubach's restoration workshop facility and the former Lewis Little Auto Museum, followed by lunch at Smithfield Station. Leaving from the YMCA in Newport News, the tour was created and led by Tony Scarpelli in his 1962 Imperial convertible. The group crossed the James River Bridge and turned right for a backroads run through Rescue, VA, then back out to get to Dwight's at the former Johns Brothers Security building. There, Dwight and his collection manager provided background on most of the cars, which included 1928 Auburn Speedsters, Mercedes 300 coupes, a custom-bodied Stutz, and 1 1937 Cord limousine. We then took backroads again to get to Smithfield and the former Lewis Little Collection. This included not only a large selection of rare Mercedes-Benz 600 limousines, but a 1960 Buick Electra 225 convertible, Jaguar and Rolls-Royce automobiles, and many other classic and collectible vehicles that included a 1932 Franklin Olympic convertible that used to belong to Neil and Marty Sugermeyer.
