Special Presentation on Pierce at February Meeting!

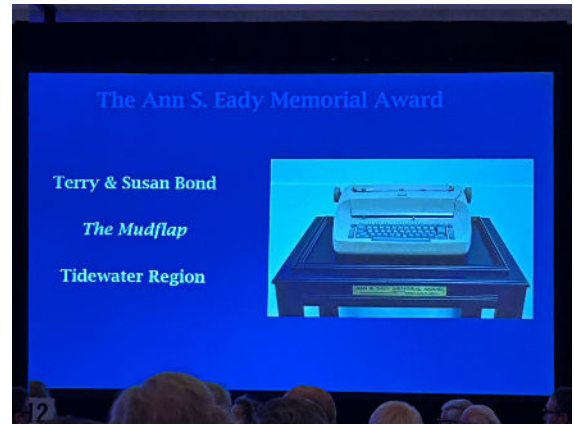
