March HVPR Meeting - History and the Pierce Family

The February Meeting of the Historic Virginia Peninsula Region (HVPR) AACA was held at the Hilton Garden Inn, Newport News VA on Tuesday February 10 2026. With 35 members in attendance. Many thanks to Donna Elliott for coordinating with the hotel & setting up the HVPR display table, Marty Sugermeyer for handling the reservations, and John Mitchell for checking in attendees. President Pete Romeo provided an overview of 2025 accomplishments, activities and thanked all volunteers and participants.

He then provided the club with planned & proposed HVPR activities for 2026 that include the Invitational Classic Car Show on Main Street Yorktown VA (need chair), meetings and weekend tours, car shows, visits to area retirement & rehabilitation facilities, and the Fall National Founders Tour (Historic Triangle) in September. All these activities will need the talents and contributions of our members. Jim Elliott brought the membership up to date on the recent National AACA Convention and Trade Show, and provided Scott Dayton with the AACA Master Webmaster Award. The highlight of the meeting was a presentation by Tom Richmond whose great - great grandfather was Geo Pierce (Pierce- Arrow Motor Car Company Buffalo NY) and whose grandfather was Percy Pierce (Pierce cycle Company and famous racer of Pierce Arrow Automobiles in the turn of the century Glidden Tours) on Pearce family history and contributions to our national automotive heritage.

Of interest Judy Cross great grandfather Charles Waterhouse was one of the founders of the Waterhouse Company Webster Mass who built custom bodies for some Pearce Arrow Cars and her grandfather Moses Sargent Waterhouse was an master upholsterer at the company. Terry Bond shared more history on the Glidden Tours and

Pearce Arrow and Waterhouse automobiles. Also Linda Crane's Grandfather worked at the Fisk Rubber Company in Chicopee Mass, and may have manufactured tires used on both Waterhouse and Pearce Arrow Automobiles. (Story and images by Al Crane)
