## HVPR members attend 1st Saturday Cruise-In

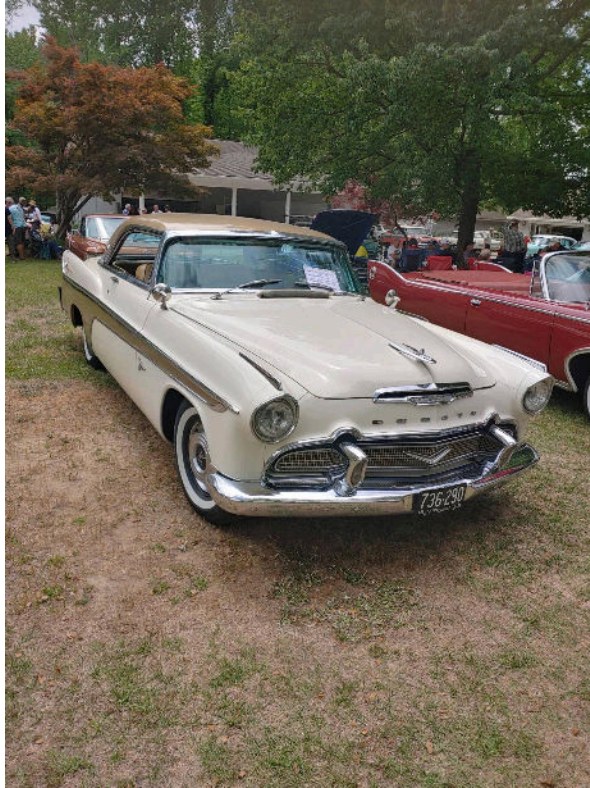
